Because of adverse weather conditions the Thorp School District will be in Synchronous Learning tomorrow. Synchronous learning requires all students to attend school from home with an electronic device. If they are unable to log in or do not have an electronic device please call the office at 509-964-2107.

We will be running busses to drop off lunch and an electronic device if we receive notice by 9 a.m, (weather permitting)

Grade school teachers will be taking attendance twice daily via check-ins on ClassDojo and secondary teachers will be taking attendance during each period. We will follow the regular school schedule with the first attendance at 8:30 a.m. Please have your student logged in and ready.

Your cooperation will allow the district to count the day and not have to extend the school year.

Teachers will check in with students and give them their homework and answer any questions. Students must be available during the school hours but will not be required to be on Zoom except to check in, receive their instructions, ask questions, and log their work on Google Calendar at the secondary level and on ClassDojo at the elementary level.
